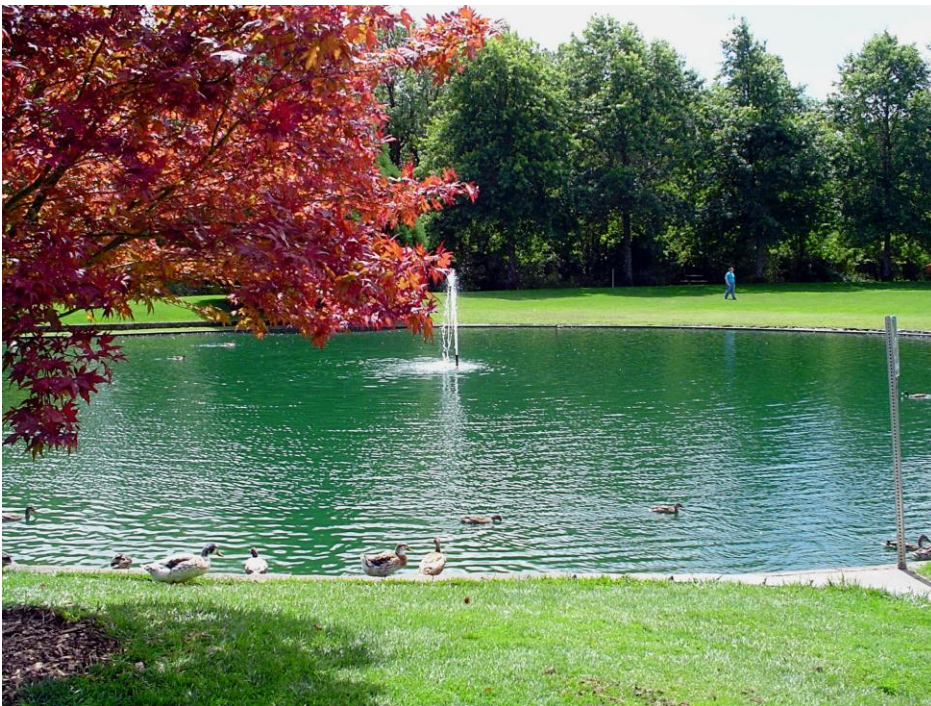


URBAN FORESTRY OUTREACH PROGRAM SPECIALIST PARKS & RECREATION
